EBONYI STATE GOVERNMENT PARTNERS AQUA POWER GULF INTERNATIONAL TO ACTUALIZE POWER GENERATION PROJECT

In her avowed determination to encourage the growth of investments in Ebonyi State by stabilizing electricity supply, the Ebonyi State Government has pledged to partner Aqua Power Gulf International to generate up to 300MW of electricity.

The state Commissioner for Trade and Investment, Chief Elechi Nnania Elechi made the pledge while in a meeting with a team from Aqua Power Gulf International in his office at Ochudo Centenary City, Abakaliki.

Chief Elechi who said that power is central to development noted that the state government would play a critical role towards the actualization of the project.

He advises Aqua Power Gulf International to carry out feasibility studies to guarantee successful implementation of the power project in the state.

The Trade and Investment Commissioner promised that the state would provide water and other things required from it in the partnership.

Speaking during the meeting, the Managing Director of Aqua Power Gulf International, Mr. Yusuf Ali noted that the project involves the process of unique technologies from quantum physics.

Mr Ali added that these technologies are rare, unique and tailored for the stability of power generation, and requires a minimal space and time to install and operate without frequent turn around maintenance.

He said another interesting future of their project is its integration of other special capabilities to provide other essential services within its primary scope.

The MD of the company stated that using their plasma chamber, their system provides perfect and safe treatment for solid waste, river, salty, sewage or any other kind of polluted water for industrial and public use
